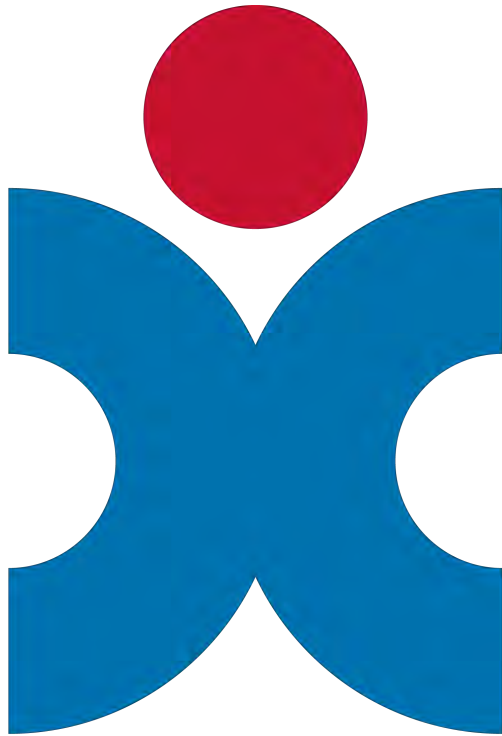

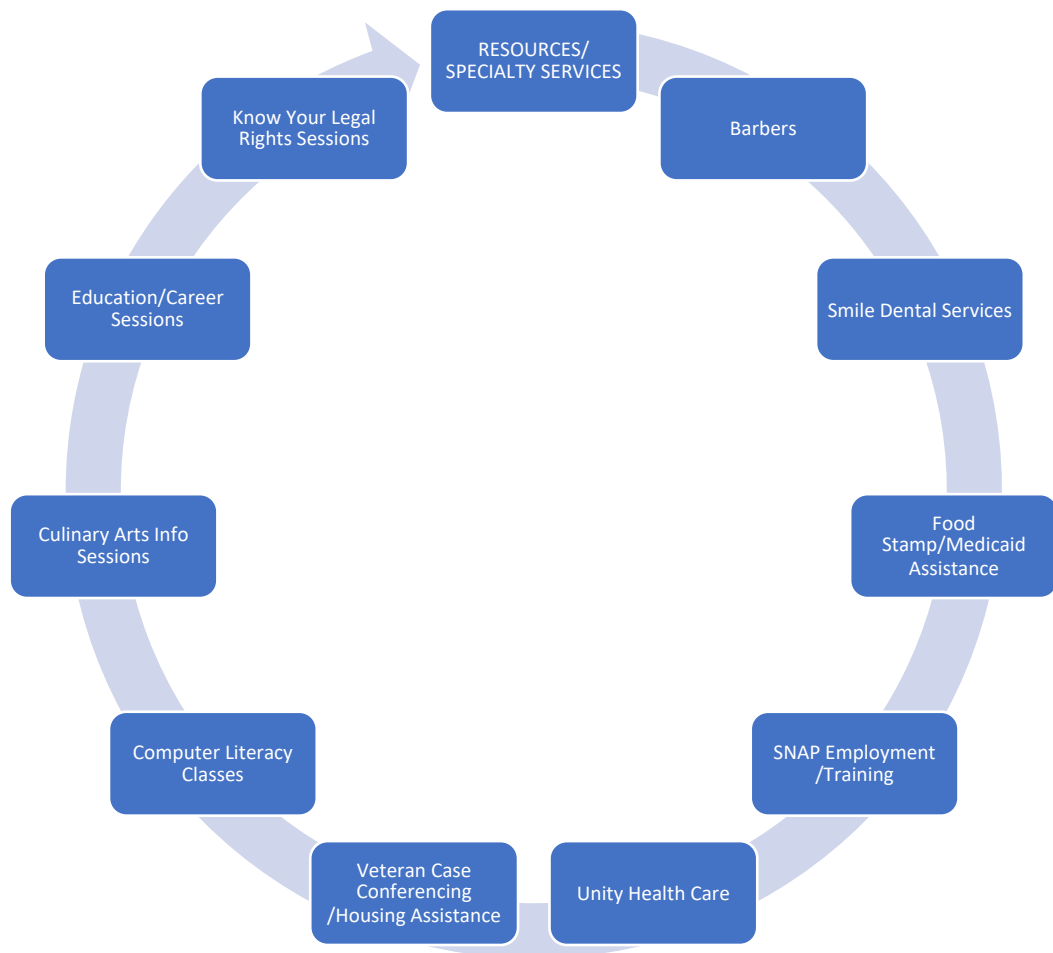
The Adams Place Drop-In Center is the well-known hidden gem in the community.

 - Veteran Case Conferencing – Tuesdays 11am (bi-weekly)

801 E. Men's Day Center

- Our Day Program is the heart and nerve center of the shelter
- Located on Martin Luther King Jr Ave SE in the 8th ward
- Our target population are the men living in the shelter and in the community, ages 18 and older
 - Low Barrier Program- A Tower, 192 Beds, Male
 - Work Bed Program- B Tower, 96 Beds, Male
 - Senior- Frail Bed Program- C Tower 2nd Fl, 48 Beds, Male
 - Medical Respite Program- C Tower 1st Fl, 12 Beds, 12 Beds, Male(6) Female (6)
 - Isolation and Quarantine(ISAQ)- C Tower 1st Fl, 12 Beds, Male(6) Female (6)



Senior Vulnerable Program

- **Eligibility...**

- 65 and older
- Documented Chronic Illness/Disability Contributing to Frailty
- Trouble with independence/frailty including weakness, trouble with walking/movement, problems with Activities of Daily Living
- Participation in Housing Focused Case Management and Medical Services are requirements of the Senior-Frail Program

801 Work Bed Program

- **Eligibility Requirements...**

- Are you working and able to verify employment?
- Are you in a Work Training program and able to verify participation in that program?
- Are you participating in an educational program and able to verify participation in the educational program?
- Do you have an active Service Plan in the Community Connections Employment Program?
- *Participation in Housing Focused Case Management is a requirement for Work Bed Program Guests*

Unisex Medical Respite Program

- 801 East Shelter offer medical respite services to all genders.
- If you had a recent surgery, medical emergency or have one scheduled, please see how you can qualify for the specialized program.



Networking/Community Presentations

- Organizations in the community visit the day center to bring resources to individuals such as:

Computer Lab

- Open daily for computer needs. Employment Specialist also available to assist with seeking employment and creating cover letters and resumes



Case Management

- One on one Case Management services is provided to guest when they visit the day center
- Assistance with obtaining vital records, medical insurance, temporary assistance with SSI benefits, etc.
- Housing navigator available in the day center to explore housing needs and available funding
- Employment specialist are available to assist with job readiness, resume writing and job searching





Job Training in Culinary and Janitorial Work

- Henry's Kitchen and Community Connections joined together in June 2022 to launch this partnership to support guest with job training and employment
- Encouraging individuals to volunteer at shelter with the goal to obtain a referral from staff to gain employment with Pelenti Janitorial

In house Community Workshops

- Community Connections staff bring specialized workshops and groups to the day center
 - Housing workshops
 - Employment workshops
 - Recovery groups
 - Peer groups
 - Life skills groups
 - Recreations



Clothing Closet

- 801 East Shelter provides clothes to clients 7 days a week between 9am to 5pm.



Additional Services

Coffee and Tea Social

- Available 7 days a week in the day center to jump start the day

Laundry Facility

- Available 7 days on the hour.
1:1 assistance available when needed

Barbershop

- 3 Barbers provide haircuts and face trims 3 days a week

Peer Support Services

- Peers connect with the individuals to provide encouragement and resources that can assist guest with moving their lives forward

Boutique

- Open daily to provide individuals with toiletries and clothing needs

Volunteer Program

- The Volunteer Peer Services Program is geared towards 801E Men's Shelter guests who have a desire to contribute back the shelter.

Case Management

- Case management is offered by Pathways to Housing DC, LLC
- One-on-One Time with a professional Case Manager or Peer Specialist
- Monday Thru Friday
- Walk-In Registration is available at the Center Front Desk

Emery Shared Rooms

- 130 bed beds (avg dorm size 8-12 people)
- 16 ADA beds
- 24 hours a day
- Intake at 7pm daily
- Early Check-in for those in the night before at 5pm

- Breakfast and Dinner is provided by Henry's and the team can make any dietary accommodations.

Emery Laundry Rooms

- Laundry services provided Monday thru Saturday for clients based on dormitory assignment that day.





Emery Conference Room
