## WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM?

Anyone who receives SNAP (Food Stamps), but is not on TANF, is eligible to participate. Those who receive TANF are eligible for work readiness and placement assistance through the Office of Work Opportunity Family Resource Center at 202.807.0405.

- A current resume (If you do not have a current resume, SNAP E&T staff will provide assistance in developing one).
